TWENTY-FIVE YEAR CLUB

In October 1970 President Walter Gage brought together University administrative heads and long-service staff members to honour them for their contributions to the University. On that occasion Dr. Gage directed the Personnel Department to create a club for staff members with 25 years of service at the University and this became known as the UBC Twenty-Five Year Club. Coordinated by the Ceremonies Office, the first official UBC Twenty-Five Year Club dinner was held at the Faculty Club on November 24, 1971.

The idea of a small memento for service was recommended by the 1st president of the club, Gene McLintock and, subsequently, Twenty-Five Year Pins were made for presentation at the annual dinner. The tradition of a pin being presented by the University President to new inductees continues to this day.

In 2004, the University began recognizing active members who had reached the additional milestone of 35 years of uninterrupted or accumulated service. And this year we will begin celebrating active members who have reached 40 years of service. In total there are now more than 1,500 members in the Twenty-Five Year Club.



The 25 Year Club Dinner is a culmination of the effort made by numerous individuals on campus, who come together with the shared goal of creating a special night for all of the honourees. We would like to acknowledge the many departments and units who have contributed to making it a memorable night.

25 YEAR CLUB COMMITTEE

The Twenty-Five Year Club committee is made up of a group of dedicated staff members, most of whom are Twenty-Five Year Club members themselves, who gather throughout the year to review eligibility criteria and plan the annual dinner. Each year a new President is selected by the committee. The committee, together with Human Resources and Ceremonies & Events, have made the celebration of UBC staff a priority as they recognize the significance of these milestones.
